2. Lawful basis for processing

Your personal data I process includes your contact details and relevant medical history you offer. The condition I apply to health data under GDPR is Article 9(2)(a) where the data subject has given explicit consent to the processing of those personal data. All data I process including the above is under Article 6(1)(b) where processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the requests of the data subject prior to entering a contract. This includes invoicing and class related communications.

3. Retention of your personal data

I will process and store your personal data only as long as is necessary to achieve the purpose of processing or as is necessary to comply with other laws. I will retain personal details of data subjects while they are active clients and for a period of 2 years thereafter in case they return to sessions within that time. Limited information (excluding health information) will be retained for up to 7 years for taxation purposes and then deleted. I have technical procedures to safeguard data with encrypted data storage.
